

## C.L. Holley Ministries FAQ

**1. Is there a specific charge for ministry visits? No.**

While there is no specific charge, our ministry does accept love offerings and/or donations to help cover travel and material for ministry. For travel over fifty miles from Huntsville AL, we humbly ASK the host to cover simple travel expenses such as plane or hotel (we normally use Hilton brand hotels for low cost and quality of stay), and a small gas and meal allowance, which can be given after completion of the event (reimbursed).

**2. What forms of payment do you accept? Credit/debit cards, checks, paypal, and cash.**

If we have discussed a particular amount before the event, Charles can send an electronic invoice that has several payment options such as various credit / debit cards, or paypal. Charles also accepts checks made out to "C.L. Holley Ministries Inc." Charles will accept cash on occasions of love offerings being taken up.

**3. How much notice do you need and would you consider "short notice" events?**

Yes, we would consider short notice events because we understand some hosts might lose a speaker/minister on short notice and need to find someone quickly. Normally, we ask for at least two weeks' notice, if possible, to properly prepare.

**4. What types of electronics and other equipment will you need for the event?**

Charles likes to use clipped mics for freedom of movement. Mics on the head area or clipped to clothing work best, but if this is not possible, a handheld mic will be okay. Charles also likes to show pictures and/or short clips and would need a projector. If your church has a modern projector screen and computer equipment, Charles can provide the media.

**5. As a host, we don't have the finances to cover travel for Charles. Can we still work something out? Yes.**

Charles does not want lack of funds to prevent God's ministry from being done. Book a virtual meeting using the "**Book Charles**" button on the website and choose "**Virtual Meeting**" and he can share some ideas such as allowing him to sell books and material during the event, taking up a free-will offering during the event, or recommending Charles to do another event at a church in your area that might be better financially suited to cover his travel expenses.

**6. As a host, we have specific rules we like for speakers/ministers to follow. Will Charles agree to follow those rules? Absolutely.**

Charles understands good shepherds will want to protect the flock and utilizing rules for guests is one way of doing that. Charles has ministered at many different denominational churches and wants to be effective. Just send Charles the rules prior to the event and he will get back with you to affirm or ask any questions.

**7. Can Charles provide a few Pastor references if needed? Absolutely, just ask.**
